In making this application, I agree to accept the following conditions and requirements:

I understand that the St. Clair County Quilt Trail (SCCQT) Committee will determine appropriateness of sites for placement of quilt blocks based on visibility, traffic density, maintenance of building and premises.

I will work with SCCQT in developing the design of the proposed quilt block and site story for SCCQT publications. The block chosen must be a quilt block traditionally made in a quilt. The quilt block design must be approved by SCCQT and must meet specifications set by SCCQT.

SCCQT will publish a block photo and story that will appear in their guide and on their website, as well as news media and future publications, social media, DVD's and other promotional opportunities.

The quilt block cannot be a company logo, nor can the installed block be used as a company logo, unless copyright regulations have been met.

The block recipient is responsible for installation and maintenance of the block. This includes visibility. The SCCQT will help coordinate installation of blocks to specifications. *The site must be accessible by a bucket truck for installation (if required) and not encumbered with power lines.*

The quilt block must remain on the building for at least five years. In the event of property ownership changes. Please inform the new owners and SCCQT.

Once the block design has been agreed upon, no changes may be made to the block and it cannot be moved or altered in any way without agreement by the SCCQT.

I will allow my barn/building to be photographed by the public and photos to be used by SCCQT in promoting the St. Clair County Quilt Trail, with my name and/or my business name to be used on promotional materials and the Quilt Trail website.

SCCQT guides and website will remind visitors on the Quilt Trail to be respectful of private property and ask permission before photographing people in conjunction with the quilt block or building.

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the St. Clair County Quilt Trail and the geographic community, as well as its officers, committees, agents and employees for and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses and causes of action related to the quilt block.
